## History Guided Pathways Map

### What is the History Guided Pathways Map?

The aim of this discipline specific map is to simplify major course selection for history majors attending El Camino College while providing transfer flexibility into either the UC or the CSU systems. By completing this history major preparation map, students declaring history as a major at El Camino College fulfill the history major preparation requirement for both the CSU History AA-T and the History UC Transfer Pathway . AA-T is an acronym for Associate in Art degree that is designed specifically for transfer to the California State University System. Students who earn a History AA-T "and meet the CSU minimum eligibility requirements are guaranteed admission to a CSU, but not necessarily to a particular campus or major. With the special degree, you may be given a GPA bump when applying to an impacted campus outside your local area or an impacted major that is deemed similar." UC Transfer Pathways provide "students with roadmaps to 21 of the most popular majors at any UC campus." They also "outlines the set of courses students should take to be competitive in one of 21 of the most popular majors found at every UC campus."

### **History Major Preparation Only**

Please note that this handout pertains to the history major preparation courses only. Additional courses will need to be completed to fulfil CSU GE or IGETC general education pattern requirements or the AA-T History Degree requirements. Please consult the appropriate forms for course requirement details. Also schedule an appointment with a counselor to ensure correct course selection and successful transfer.

### **Academic Counseling**

Students need to meet with an academic counselor to identify the best combination of courses to take while attending El Camino College to ensure successful transfer. The History Department encourages students to work regularly with an academic counselor.
