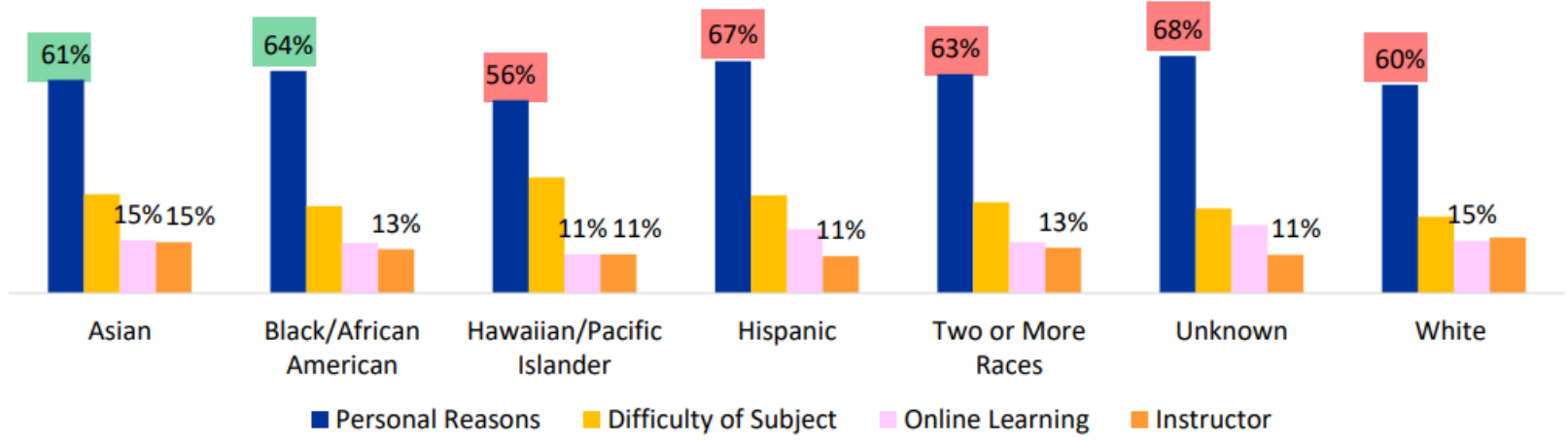

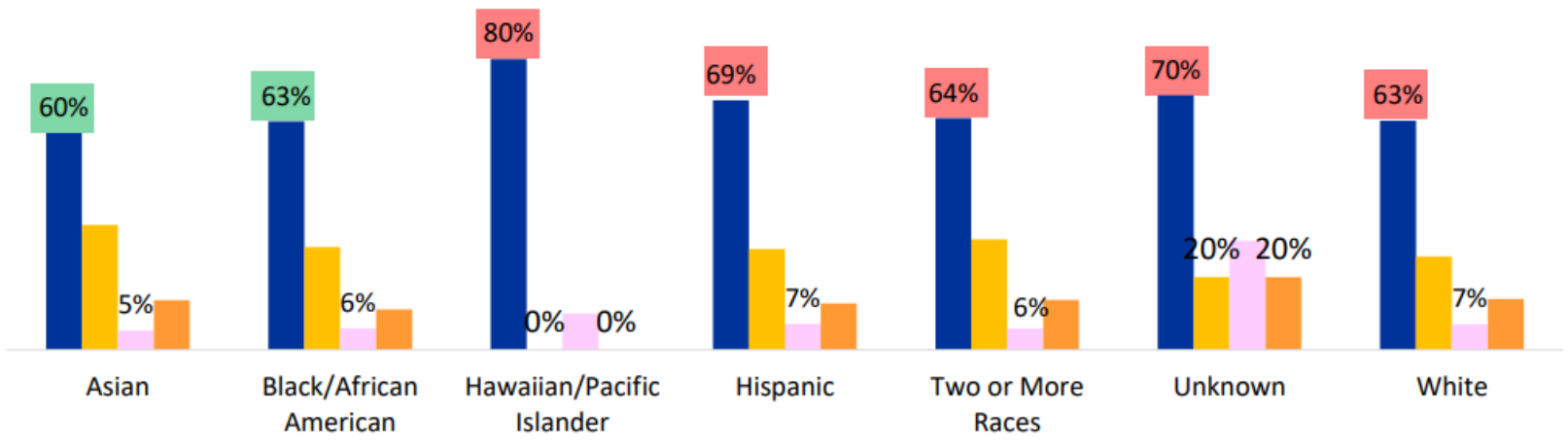

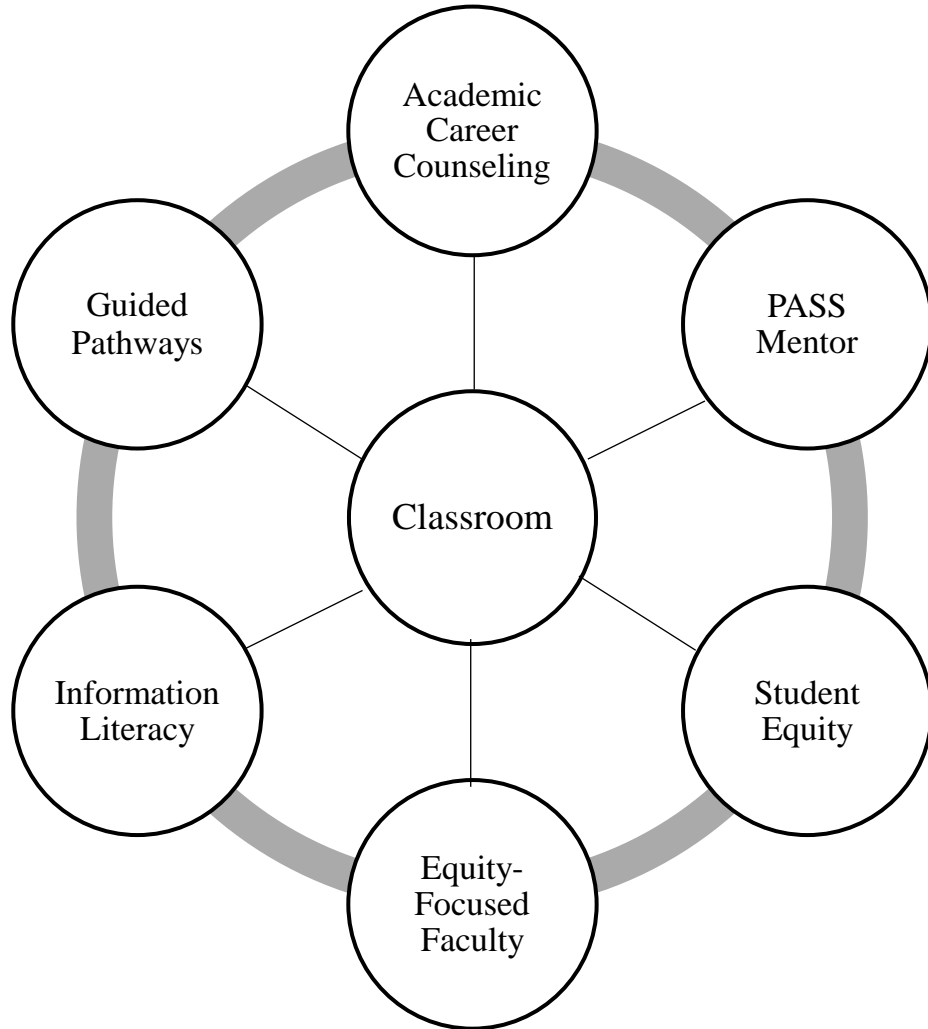

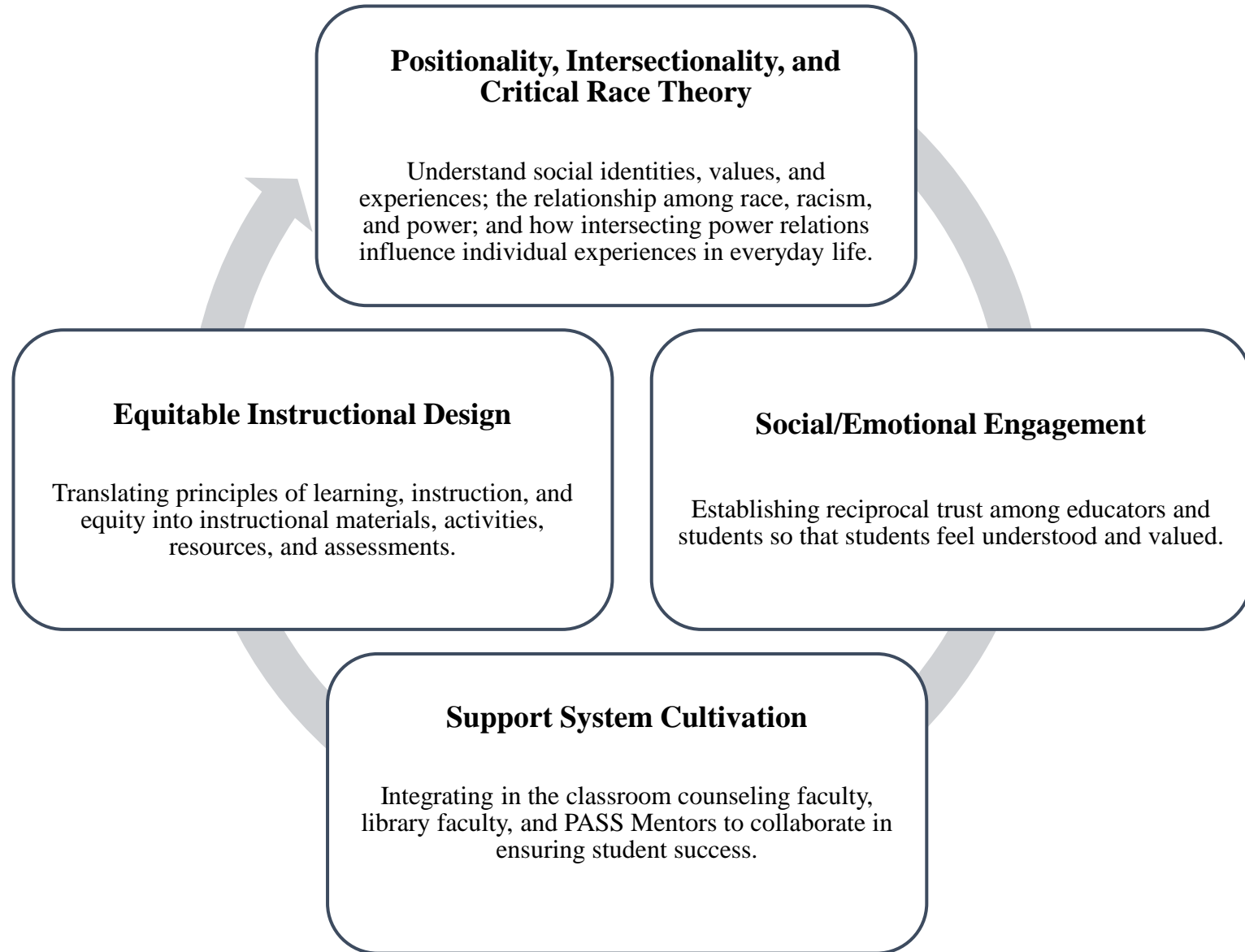
It is a **pedagogical partnership model** that = three objectives:

1. Move faculty to evaluate how **their curriculum, teaching methods, views on student learning, assignment design, and content delivery** may be contributing to **equity gaps**.
2. Integrate **Guided Pathways principles, Vision 2030 goals and SEA metrics** by bringing together in the classroom **counseling faculty, teaching faculty, library faculty, and PASS Mentors**.
3. Create a **programmatic experience** for all students enrolled myPATH designated courses.
